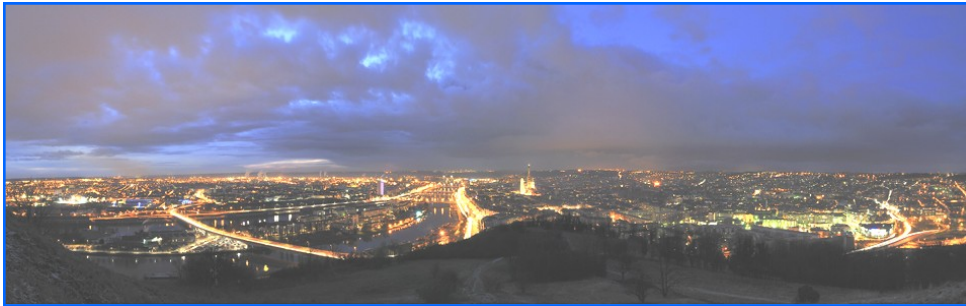

Registration Conditions

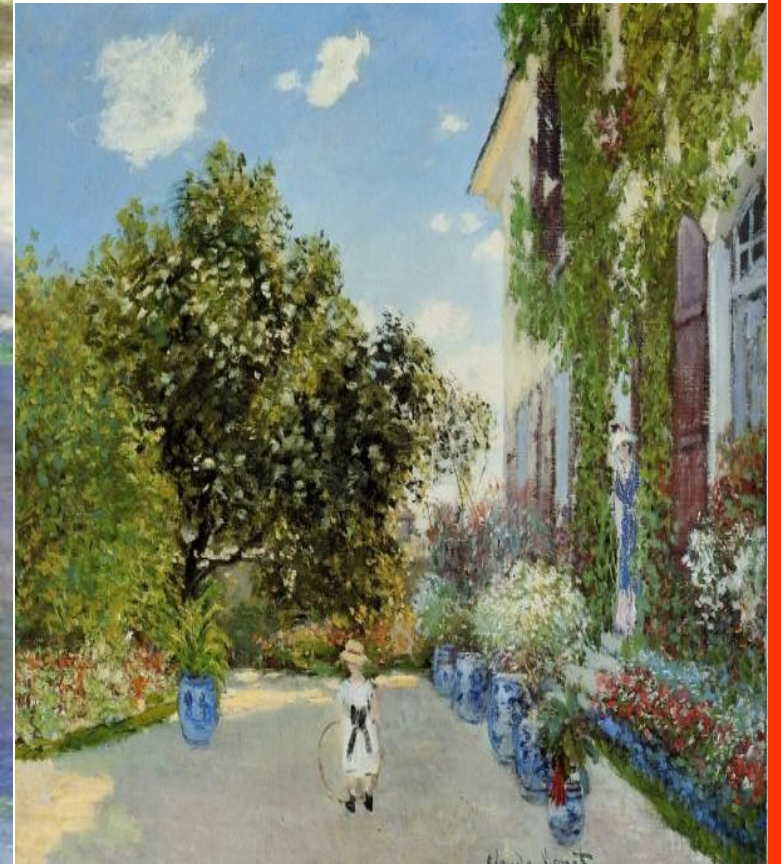
- Pre-requisites: None. It is preferable to have Level 2 of CECR.
