ALLIANCE FRANÇAISE DE ROUEN

One hour from Paris, the Alliance Française offers intensive general courses in French as well as specialised courses in particular areas such as business, tourism, literature, and gastronomy. The programme allows you to enjoy living with a French family, sharing breakfast and dinner with them. If you wish, other accommodation can be arranged, such as studio apartments.

The Alliance Française de Rouen is famous for its quality of teaching. All teachers are native speakers and have extensive experience in teaching French to foreigners, both adults and adolescents. They are enthusiastic and do their utmost to enable students to speak French very quickly.

Rouen, the capital city of Normandy, is rich in cultural and architectural treasures, and will be the point of departure for your excursions to Mont Saint Michel, D-Day landing beaches and Paris.



INSURANCE

All students are required to have insurance for health care, accident cover and personal liability. This can be done by taking out a travel insurance policy. Paying for this insurance is the responsibility of the student. Additional trip insurance is recommended.

PROGRAM FEE INCLUDES:

- Evaluation test for students who are not beginners in order that they may be placed in a class corresponding to their skill level.
- Forty-five hours of language tuition at the Alliance Française de Rouen,
- Presentations on cultural aspects of France including art, history, literature and architecture,
- All excursions and visits as listed in the programme including transport and entry fees and professional bilingual guide.
- Accommodation with homestay family in Rouen and hostel accommodation elsewhere.
- Breakfast and dinner
- Wine tastings and cooking classes
- Alliance Française Certificate showing number of hours of attendance and level of class.

THE PROGRAM FEE DOES NOT INCLUDE:

Transportation to France, independent travel; personal items: passport, visas, medical, accident, baggage loss, personal liability, trip cancellation insurance, lunches.

REGISTRATION AND PAYMENT



To be admitted to the school, you must be at least 18 years of age and meet the French legal requirements for a stay in France. However, if you are between 16 and 18 years of age you may be admitted if you provide proof of parental consent. The school cannot be held responsible for difficulties arising in the process of applying for a long-stay visa or the permission to reside in France (*carte de séjour*).

The registration is only complete with the payment of 320 Euros deposit. This can be done by secure online payment.

Upon receiving the completed online enrolment and the deposit, the school will issue a certificate of pre-registration. You will receive the address of your accommodation at least one week before arrival.

CHANGES

The school reserves the right to cancel or modify the pricing and/or time of any course.

CANCELLATIONS

The deposit for the programme is deducted from the total amount due, but is not refundable under any circumstance.

FINAL PAYMENT

Final payment is due on the first day of the course. Tuition fees are not refundable in the case of absence or early departure, except in the case of unexpected illness as attested by a doctor's certificate. However, tuition payment and attendance may be deferred for up to 4 months. Requests for such a deferral must be received by the school administration at least 15 days prior to the scheduled starting date of the course.
