

GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS

ADMISSION

To be admitted to the school, candidates must be at least 18 years of age and meet the French legal requirements for a stay in France. However, candidates between 16 and 18 years of age may be admitted if they can provide proof of parental consent. The school cannot be held responsible for difficulties arising in the process of applying for a long-stay visa or the permission to reside in France (carte de séjour).

ENROLMENT

The enrolment fee is 70 Euros per year for the materials provided to the student.

WAYS TO ENROL

PRE-ENROLMENT: To enrol in advance, one may send the following by mail, fax or email:

-The completed enrolment application and a deposit of:

- * 200 Euros for less than 3 months of courses or
- * 400 Euros for more than 3 months of courses, plus
- *50 Euros administration fee for accommodation request, if needed

Please Note: The deposits for the courses are deducted from the total amount due, but are not refundable.

Upon receiving the completed enrolment form and the appropriate fees, the school will send by return mail a certificate of pre-enrolment. The student will receive the address of the accommodations one week before arrival.

ENROLMENT ON-SITE:

It is possible to enrol at the school and pay the enrolment and tuition fees prior to taking the first course.

CONFIRMATION:

Students must complete the confirmation process at the school no later than the Monday morning of their first class. It is necessary to bring with you the following documents:

- Proof of identity: a national identity card, the carte de séjour, a passport with a visa valid for the duration of the studies.
- Two identity-card sized photos
- The receipt for payment of fees and the certificate of pre-enrolment

Students who are not beginners will take an evaluation test in order that they may be placed in a class corresponding to their skill level.

CHANGES

The school reserves the right to cancel or modify the pricing and/or time of any course.

INSURANCE

Students must have insurance for health care, accident, and personal liability. Acquiring and paying for this insurance is the responsibility of the student.

CANCELLATIONS

Request for accommodation: The fees for accommodation application are neither refundable nor transferable.

Enrolment fee: Application fees are not refundable in any case.

TUITION PAYMENT

Tuition fees must be paid at the beginning of each month, and are not refundable in the case of absence or early departure, except in the case of unexpected illness as attested by a doctor's certificate. However, tuition payment and attendance may be delayed for up to 4 months. Requests for such a delay must be received by the school administration at least 15 days prior to the scheduled starting date of the course. To take advantage of the special B & C week rate the entirety of the fees must be paid by the first day of the first class.

In case of dispute only the tribunal of Rouen is recognized.

GENERAL COURSES

Courses begin each Monday for all levels (except beginners)

Beginners courses start:

January 5, February 16, March 30, May 18, June 29, August 3 & 31, September 28,
November 9

In 2009, classes will not be held on the following dates
(courses non-refundable, non-transferable) :

Thursday January 1st, Monday April 13th (Easter), Friday May 1st (Labor Day), Friday
May 8th (Victory Day), Thursday May 21th (ascension), Tuesday July 14th (Bastille
Day), Wednesday November 11th (Armistice 1918), and Friday December 25th
(Christmas).

Basic Courses: 15 hours each week (3 hours each morning) grouped by level. 142
€uros per week maximum; costs are progressively reduced after 4 weeks.

Intensive Courses: 20 hours each week (basic course plus one hour of workshops each
afternoon) grouped by level. 189 €uros per week maximum: costs are progressively
reduced after 4 weeks.

Super Intensive Courses: 25 hours per week (basic course plus 2 hours of workshops
each afternoon) grouped by level. 235 €uros per week maximum: costs are progres-
sively reduced after 4 weeks.

Intensive Courses Plus: Intensive courses + 5 hours of specialized courses + test: 495
€uros for 1 week, 960 €uros for 2 weeks, 1400 €urofor 3 weeks.

Courses for au pairs: Students working as au pairs can take courses in 3-hour
sessions, 270 € for 10 x 3 hour classes.

Evening Classes: 2 x 2 hour classes each week (Tuesday and Thursday) for a minimum
of 8 weeks: 288 €uros for 32 hours.

Specialized (One to One) Courses: 65 €uros per hour

Distance Courses (by telephone): 15 €uros for 15 minutes

Exam Preparation: Starting at 9 €uros per hour
